October 7, 1924 - April 6, 2025

Betty J. Green, 100, of Bellmont, died Sunday, April 6, 2025, at home surrounded by loving family.

Born on October 7, 1924, in Malone, NY, she was the daughter of Ernest L. and Luella (Barney) Harwood. Betty graduated from Franklin Academy, Malone, in 1940 at the age of 16. She was married to Harold Premo on October 24, 1942. He was a paratrooper killed in action in Normandy on June 6, 1944.

She married George E. Green on January 18, 1947, in the First Congregational Church, Malone, NY. He predeceased her on April 24, 2001. During her marriage, she traveled with her husband and children, moving each year around the United States as part of his job. She returned to Malone in 1968 where she worked for Dr. Leon Benardot and then Alice Hyde Hospital until her retirement. Many will also fondly remember her as the "Avon Lady." She is survived by her three children: Murri Chase of Chateaugay Lake, Gary Green of Chateaugay Lake and Nancy (Green) Daley and her husband, Michael of Clifton Park along with six grandchildren, six great-grandchildren, her sister-in-law, Cathy Harwood of Duane and many nieces and nephews. Besides her husbands, she was predeceased by two brothers, Jack and James Harwood and her granddaughter, Meredith Chase Bruce.

She was a longtime member of the Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses in Malone, NY where her memorial will be held on May 3, 2025, at 1:00 PM.
