Brian J. Coughlin, 65, of Burke, New York died Monday, Sept. 6, 2021 at CVPH Medical Center, Plattsburgh. He was a resident of The Alice Center since 2018.

Born on Sept. 28, 1955 in Malone, New York, he was the son of Vernon and Valda (Brockway) Coughlin.

He was married to Margaret "Peggy" Brockway on Aug. 3, 1985 in St. George's Church, Burke by Rev. Paul Beyette.

Brian graduated from Franklin Academy and was a proud member of the Future Farmers of America. Brian and his wife, Peggy owned and operated the Coughlin Family Farm in Burke for all their married life.
