It is with deep sadness we announce the passing of our brother, Brian Savoir on Friday, November 15, 2019 after a very long battle with cancer.

Born in Malone, New York on December 15, 1948 he was the son of the late William and Adeline (Vermette) Savoir of Westville, NY.

Brian grew up in Westville and graduated from Salmon River Central School in 1966. He then went on to join the Army and was a very proud Vietnam Vet, serving as a Staff Sergeant and with the Military Police.
