Honorable Charles S. Robert, "Charlie", 75, of Malone died Friday, April 18, 2025, at the Alice Hyde Medical Center.

Born on January 26, 1950, in Malone, NY, he was the son of Wilding and Pauline (Gervais) Robert. They predeceased him.

He was married to Deborah Sweet on July 23, 1982, at their home.

Charlie graduated from St. Joseph's Academy and attended Paul Smith's College and Canton ATC. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy on October 15, 1969. He served aboard the USS Stonewall Jackson as the torpedo man on the gold crew. He was honorably discharged on October 12, 1973. He was employed as a corrections officer and weapons trainer, retiring from Upstate Correctional Facility in 2002. Charlie was very active in the community serving as Malone Code Enforcement Officer for 13 years, Malone Town Justice for 5 years and was a member of the Malone American Legion. He was also a communicant of St. Andre Bessette Parish. For 40 years, Charlie owned and operated his stump grinding business. He enjoyed playing cards and hunting. He loved spending time with his children and grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife, Debbie of 42 years; two children, Christopher Robert and his wife, Katie of Concord, NH, Jenn Johnston and her husband, Tommie of Chateaugay; five grandchildren, Madelyn, Norah and Charlotte Robert, Adelynn and Presley Johnston.
