Donald W. Carr, 91, of Chateaugay Lake died Friday, June 23, 2023 at Meadowbrook Healthcare, Plattsburgh.

Born February 2, 1932 in Burke, NY, the son of John Miles and Eula (Vincent) Carr.

He graduated from Chateaugay High School. He was honorably discharged from the United States Army after serving in the U.S., Japan and Korea.

In 1959, Donald was united in marriage to Berenice Monique at St. Joseph's Church in Huntingdon, Quebec.

He was employed by the Niagara Mohawk Power Corp. for 36 years, retiring on April 1, 1991 as Supervisor of Electric and Transmission Lines at Saranac Lake, NY.

Besides his wife of 64 years, he is survived by several nieces and nephews.

Besides his parents, he was predeceased by two sisters, Martha Leach and Eileen Johnston and a brother, Wendell Carr.

Donald was a former communicant of St. Jude's Church, Brainardsville and a communicant of St. Patrick's Church. He served on the Pastoral Council, was a lector, eucharistic minister and a commissioned lay minister.

He was an avid hunter, fisherman and snowmobiler and a member of the Bellmont Hi-Riders. Donald and Berenice were active at the Burke Adult Center and volunteered with meals on wheels.

Calling hours will be held at the Chateaugay Funeral Home on Friday, June 30, 2023 from 10 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at Notre Dame Church, Malone on Friday, June 30 at noon.

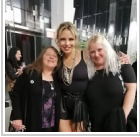
I have Uncle Don't BBQ recipe for chicken if you want it Pam. It was a staple in our summer visits with them. I think of him every time we make it.
