Doris J. Gardner, 88, of Malone, NY died Thursday, August 13, 2020 at her son's home with her son, Charlie and daughter-in-law, Penny by her side. Born on June 6, 1932 in Malone, NY, she was the daughter of Mary Jane Robinson Badore.
