Dorothee E. Abbott, 95, of Chateaugay died Thursday, Aug. 18, 2022 at the Alice Hyde Medical Center.

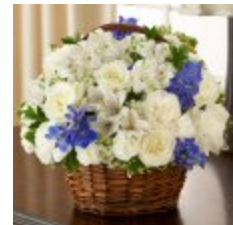

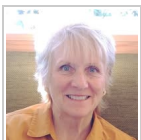
