



Mrs. Dorothy O. Shea

Dorothy O. Shea, 98, formerly of Trout River died Thursday, Aug. 4, 2022 at The Alice Center with her family at her side.

Born on Dec. 27, 1923 in Cornwall, Ontario, she was the daughter of Herman and Laura (LeClair) Keefe.

She graduated from St. Joseph's Academy in 1941 and attended St. Vincent's School of Nursing in New York City for two years.

On Dec. 27, 1944, she was united in marriage to John D. Shea in St. Bridget's Church, Trout River by Rev. Earl Taylor. He predeceased her on Jan. 23, 1990.

Dorothy was a communicant of St. Francis of Assisi Church, Constable where she was a member of the parish council and the Altar and Rosary Society. She was a former member of St. Bridget's Church, Trout River and was the organist for several years. She was also a former member of the Constable Volunteer Fire Department Auxiliary.

Surviving are four sons, Patrick (Darlene) of Dade City, FL, Michael (Susan) of Constable, John II (Sybil) of Malone, Daniel (Nancy) of Ponce Inlet, FL; four daughters, Sheila (Roger) Bouton of Colorado Springs, CO, Mary Kay (Robert) Smith of Malone, Dorothy Anne (Steven) Reynolds of Malone, Bridget (Greg) Janisewski of Chateaugay; 14 grandchildren; 16 great-grandchildren and a great-great-grandchild.

Besides her husband, she was predeceased by her parents; two sisters, Sheila Minard and Joan Dickhaut.

Calling hours will be held at St. Francis of Assisi Church on Thursday from 10 am. to 12 p.m. A Mass of Christian Burial will immediately follow at 12 p.m. Burial will take place at St. Francis Cemetery.
