Emma J. Tolosky “Mrs. T.”, 92, of Belle Ave, Chateaugay, passed away Monday, November 29, 2021 at the Alice Center.

Born on August 10, 1929 in Chateaugay, NY, she was the daughter of Arthur and Margery (Mills) Jones.

She was married to Russell R. Tolosky on July 1, 1950 in St. Patrick’s Church, Chateaugay by Rev. George Tobin. He predeceased her on March 10, 2011.

Mrs. Tolosky graduated from Chateaugay Central School in 1946 and continued her education at Plattsburgh State and University of Albany where she received her master’s degree in education. She worked at Chateaugay Central School as a teacher before retiring in 1987 after 37 years of service. She was a communicant of St. Patrick’s Church.
