



## Mr. Eric Evan Livernois

December 8, 1965 - August 22, 2024

Eric Evan Livernois, 58, of Owls Head died Thursday, August 22, 2024, at his home surrounded by his loving family and under the care of Hospice of the North Country.

Born on December 8, 1965, in Malone, NY, he was the son of Earl E. Livernois Sr. and Patricia (Marshall) Livernois.

Eric graduated from Franklin Academy with the Class of 1984. He was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant through Army ROTC serving Active Duty in the Army Reserves and Army National Guard reaching the rank of Major when on Active Duty at Fort Drum after 9/11. He attended SUNY Canton and SUNY Potsdam, graduating with three bachelor's degrees. Eric owned and operated his own construction business for many years. He was a communicant of St. Andre Bessette Parish and a life member of both the Amvets and American Legion Post 1623. He was very involved with OHMV Community Connection – Patsy's Place, where he served as a member of the Board.

He is survived by three sons, Joshua Livernois of Owls Head; Devan Livernois of Owls Head; John Henderson of Malone; two grandchildren, Kirra Livernois of Owls Head and Jacob Henderson of Malone; a brother, Earl E. Livernois Jr. and his wife, Beth of Brushton; two sisters, Bernadine Livernois and Darlene Livernois, both of Owls Head; the mother of his children, Michelle Riley Livernois; and two nieces, Shelley Hazen of Moira and Tricia Livernois of Brushton.

He was predeceased by his parents, Earl and Patricia; and a sister, Annette.
