Ernest L. Gero, 88, of State Route 11, Burke passed away Thursday, October 28, 2021 at his home with his loving family by his side and aided by Hospice of the North Country.

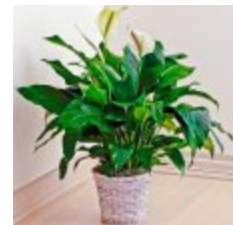
