



Mr. Frank L. Woodward III

June 2, 1949 - January 1, 2024

Frank L. Woodward III, 74, of Lyon Mountain died Monday, January 1, 2024, at his home surrounded by his loving family and under the care of Hospice of the North Country.

Born on June 2, 1949, in Plattsburgh, NY, he was the son of Frank and Irene (Ducharme) Woodward.

He was married to Debbie LaPoint on August 4, 1979, at St. Bernard's Church, Lyon Mountain.

Frank graduated from Lyon Mountain High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corp on June 30, 1967, and was honorably discharged on June 29, 1971, after serving in Vietnam. Frank was employed by Freihofer Baking Company and retired after several years of service. He was a communicant of St. Bernard's Church, member of the Sorrell-Woodward American Legion Post 1623, lifetime member of the VFW, member and former fire chief of the Lyon Mountain Fire Department. Frank enjoyed woodworking, hunting, snowmobiling, bowling and spending time with family.

He is survived by his wife, Debbie of 44 years; a son and daughter-in-law, Frank and Yvonne Woodward of Wilson, NY; four grandchildren; two sisters, Sybil Woodward of Lyon Mountain, Kathryn Cooper of Rouses Point; a brother and sister-in-law, Edwin and Gerry Woodward of Chazy Lake; several nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his parents; two brothers, Joseph and David Woodward and a sister, Lynda Holland.
