George Candido, 93, of the Finney Rd., Burke died Saturday, May 11, 2019 at his home surrounded by his loving family under the care of Hospice of the North Country.

Born on July 4, 1925 in New Bedford, MA, he was the son of Joao Pedro Candido and Maria De Gloria Andrade.

He was married to Alice Maciel on August 2, 1947 at Immaculate Conception Church, New Bedford, MA. She predeceased him on April 14, 2012.

Mr. Candido graduated from B.M.C. Durfee High School in Fall River, MA. He enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corp in June 1943 and was honorably discharged in May 1946. He owned and operated Candi Spring Farm in Fall River, MA, Cornwall, VT and later Burke, NY. He was a communicant of St. George's Church, Burke and St. Patrick's Church, Chateaugay. He was a member of the Cornwall, VT Fire Dept., the Grange, American Legion and the Knights of Columbus.

Mr. Candido enjoyed gardening, and hunting. Family and friends were most important to him.

He is survived by five children, Constance St. George and her husband, Gary Gorton of Salisbury, VT, George Candido Jr. and his wife, Jane of Sprakers, NY, Gloria Candido of Burlington, Vt, Joseph and James Candido of Burke, NY, 12 grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren.

Besides his wife, he was predeceased by his parents; siblings, Mary Murphy, Jack and Antone Candido, Maria de Ceu Almeida Fernandes and DeoLinda

Almeida.
