



## Mr. George William Douglas

March 10, 1932 - May 29, 2016

George William Douglas, 84, of Chateaugay, NY, died May 29, 2016 at the Alice Center, Malone, NY after several months of battling diabetes and heart related illnesses.

Born in Chateaugay on March 10, 1932, he was the son of Frank and Anna (Granger) Douglas who predeceased him.

George married Rose Marie Dupree on September 24, 1955 in Chateaugay and they shared 57 years together before her passing in July of 2013.

He was a graduate of Chateaugay High School and a veteran of the Korean War. He worked at Alcoa in Massena, BOCES of Franklin, Essex, and Hamilton counties, the Franklin County Fairgrounds, and delivered meals for the Burke Adult Center. His greatest passion, however, was as a farmer for 30 years raising his family with Rose on the Douglas Homestead where they lived for 55 years. George was a member of the American Legion Post 875 of Chateaugay and Knights of Columbus 469 Wadhams Council of Chateaugay. He also enjoyed weekly card games, daily lunch at the adult center, casual games of golf, bird watching, and especially time with his family.
