Gerald H. Lawrence, 73, of Westville, died Tuesday, September 17, 2019 at the Alice Center, Malone.

Born on October 16, 1945 in Malone, NY, he was the son of Bert and Anna (Taylor) Lawrence.

He was married to Sharon Burgess on July 27, 1968 in Portland, Maine.

Gerald graduated from Chateaugay Central School in 1963. He enlisted in the United States Navy in 1963 and was honorably discharged in 1967.
