Hugh McMahan, 84, of Malone passed away at his home on the morning of April 20th with his family by his side and under the care of Hospice of the North Country.

Born on March 13, 1940, in Malone, NY, he was the son of the late Thomas and late Mary McMahan. He was a graduate of Franklin Academy in Malone. He was married to the former Lorraine Young on September 6, 1958, at St. John Bosco Church in Malone by Father Revette. She predeceased him on December 5, 2021.

Hugh joined the Malone Fire Department in 1966, working his way up the ranks to Fire Chief where he was Fire Chief for 2 terms and received the President Cup in 1982. Hugh loved leaving the snowy weather behind, where he wintered in Zephyrhills, Florida with his wife Lorraine, returning in the spring in time to plan many camping trips on the St. Lawrence River. He enjoyed hunting and was a former member of the Stony Brook Club Association where he took many hunting trips with friends and family.

He is survived by his daughter, Deborah McMahan; 2 sons, Timothy and his wife, Carmen and Michael and his fiancé, Nicole Guerin; his 4 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. Also surviving are his brother, Raymond (Donna)

McMahon and sister, Theresa (Joseph) Laprad. He was predeceased by his wife, Lorraine, brother, Thomas and brother-in-law, Joseph.
