James Robert Cook, 71, of the Jericho Rd., Chateaugay died Sunday, Dec. 28, 2014 at his home surrounded by his loving family and Hospice of the North Country.

Born in Chateaugay, NY on July 30, 1943, he was the son of Lloyd and Almira (Porter) Cook.
