“ I remember as a boy bringing my bike's flat tire to Jim at his service station at the corner of Willow and East Main. He brought me into his shop and patiently showed me how to look for the hole in the inner tube and to check the tread to see what caused it. He applied the patch with glue and used a tool that looked like a small pizza cutter to make sure it was on tight. He'd put soapy water around the patch and blow up the tube to make sure it didn't leak. Then he'd let the air out, put it back on the rim, blow it partially up again, and finish wedging the tire back onto the rim. He filled the tire fully and showed me how to check for the correct pressure. He'd put it on an axle and check the straightness of the rim and adjust the spokes as necessary. Then he gave me the tire, walked me to the front to see Pat and charged me maybe a dollar. Then I was on my way.

*Jim exemplified what growing up in a small town like Malone in the 60's and 70's was all about. He contributed to the well being of many people, including myself. I am grateful and honored to have known him.*
