Janet Irene Noel, 92, of Morrisonville, NY, formerly of Chateaugay Lake died Friday, January 15, 2016 at Meadowbrook Nursing Home, Plattsburgh, NY. Born in Greenville, NY on February 25, 1923, she was the daughter of Ford and Pearl (Walters) Roe. She was married to Francis M. Noel on July 5, 1947 in Catskill, NY. He predeceased her on 1993.

Mrs. Noel graduated from Albany State College for Teachers in 1944. She taught in both Ellenburg and Lyon Mountain schools. She resided at Chateaugay Lake for 46 years before moving to Plattsburgh in 1993. She was a member of the New York State Retired Teachers Association, Senior Citizens Council of Clinton County, and a former communicant of St. Bernard's Church in Lyon Mountain.
