Janice (Brooks) Shannon, 66, of the Arnold Road, Plattsburgh, died Oct. 4, 2012, in the presence of her loving family, after a lengthy battle with cancer. She was born on Sept. 26, 1946 in Plattsburgh, the daughter of Harold and Helma (Yelle) Brooks.
