Jeanne E. Lantry, 93, of Malone died Wednesday, January 31, 2018 at The Alice Center, Malone.

Born on Jan. 27, 1925 in Cornwall, Ontario, Canada, she was the daughter of Michael and Mary (Quinn) Lantry.

In her early years, Jeanne lived in Hogansburg, later moving to Malone and graduating from St. John's High School, Plattsburgh in 1943. She then graduated from Plattsburgh State University School of Nursing with her Registered Nurse's degree in 1946. She returned to Malone to make her home and was employed by the Malone Central School District as a nurse/teacher for 35 years, retiring in 1985. Jeanne served in the U.S. Army Reserves where she achieved the rank of Major and was Chief Nurse for 16 years. She was a communicant of St. Joseph's Church, Malone, and a member of the NYS Retired Teachers Association, former member of the College Club.

She is survived by a brother, John Lantry of New York, NY; a sister, Barbara Galati of Clifton Park, NY; two nieces and four nephews.

She was predeceased by her parents and two brothers, Joseph and James Lantry.
