



## Mr. John H. McCarthy

August 1, 1932 - March 29, 2024

John H. McCarthy, 91, of Malone died Friday, March 29, 2024, at Elderwood of Uihlein Nursing Home, Lake Placid.

Born on August 1, 1932, in Tupper Lake, NY, he was the son of Harry and Agnes (Devlin) McCarthy.

He was married to Joyce Beane on March 2, 1957, at St. John Bosco Church. She predeceased him on June 6, 2022.

After graduating from high school, John enlisted in the U.S. Navy on November 15, 1951. He served aboard the USS Cassin Young in Japan and Puerto Rico among other locations. He was a member of the Malone Rotary Club, the Police Benevolent Association of the New York State Troopers, the Malone Lodge of Elks, Malone Amvets where he served as past commander, Malone American Legion and the Malone Veteran's Firing Squad. John made deliveries for Meals on Wheels. He loved to hunt and restore classic tractors. The love of his life were his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

He is survived by three children, Daniel (Julie) McCarthy, Colleen (Vincent)
