Keith E. Trudeau, 77, of Burke, passed away Wednesday, May 25, 2022 at UVM Medical Center, Burlington, VT.

Born on August 28, 1944 in Plattsburgh, NY, he was the son of H. Murray and Winnifered (Garland) Trudeau.

He was married to Linda Tacy on December 12, 1970 in Schuyler Falls. She predeceased him on April 13, 2011.

Keith graduated from Mount Assumption Institute in Plattsburgh and received a Bachelor's degree from SUNY Plattsburgh. He served in the Army Reserves. He was employed as an ad salesman for the Press Republican, KB Auto and the Free Trader. He owned and operated "Mr. Dresser" for many years selling used and refurbished dressers and lawn equipment in Burke. He was a member of the Burke Town Board. He enjoyed going to the casino and watching baseball and football.


