



## Mr. Kenneth Moose Gregory

July 3, 1938 - July 8, 2014

Kenneth J. "Moose" Gregory, 76, of State Rt. 374, Lyon Mountain died Tuesday, July 8, 2014 at CVPH Medical Center, Plattsburgh, NY.

Born in Plattsburgh, NY on July 3, 1938, he was the son of Harold and Ina (Revor) Gregory. They predeceased him.

Mr. Gregory graduated from Lyon Mountain High School. In his early years, he was employed at the missile site and Eisenhower Locks at the St. Lawrence Seaway. He later owned and operated Greg's Tavern in Lyon Mountain for over 30 years which is now the Lyon Mountain Museum. He sponsored the Lyon Mountain Miner's baseball team and little league baseball. Mr. Gregory was a communicant of St. Bernard's Church, Lyon Mountain.

Mr. Gregory is survived by a brother and sister-in-law, Ronald and Sharon Gregory of Ballston Lake; two nieces, Nikki Parks of Rotterdam, Keri McGuire of Fort Myers, FL; a grandnephew, Josh McIntosh; a grandniece, Autumn Parks.
