



## Mr. Kenneth D. Robert

April 11, 1927 - September 4, 2018

Kenneth D. Robert, 91, of Malone died Tuesday, Sept. 4, 2018 at The Alice Center, Malone.

Born on April 11, 1927 in Malone, NY, he was the son of Eugene and Anna (Gosline) Robert.

He was married to Inez St. Ann on April 15, 1950. She predeceased him on Sept. 13, 1995.

Mr. Robert lived all of his life in Malone and attended local schools. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1944, serving in the Pacific Theater during World War II. He was honorably discharged in 1946. He returned home and began working for NY Central Railroad for 11 years and operating a grocery store in Whippleville for 10 years. He then opened Ken's Liquor Store in 1969, operating the store for 20 years until his retirement in 1989.

Mr. Robert was a communicant of Notre Dame Church and Third-Degree member of the Knights of Columbus. He was also a member of the American Legion Post 219, the Malone Adult Center where he volunteered and a former member of the Elks and Amvets.

He is survived by five sons, Barry Robert and his wife, Nancy of Forestport, NY, Mark Robert of Malone, Jeffrey Robert of Granada Hills, CA, Joel Robert and his companion, Janice Chester of St. Regis Falls, Cory Robert of Moira; four grandchildren, Paul, Eric and Kristin Robert and Cody Chester; several nieces and nephews.

Besides his wife, he was predeceased by his parents; nine brothers, Wilfred,

Norman, Arthur, Wilding, Clarence, Raymond, Gilbert, LeRoy and Eli "Whity"  
Robert and a sister, Bernice Robert.
