Kieth E. Smith, 80, of Elm St. Malone died Friday, March 3, 2017 at UVM Medical Center, Burlington, VT.

Born on Oct. 16, 1936 in Burke, NY, he was the son of Earl and Esther (Moore) Smith. They predeceased him.
