Louise Glazier Taylor, 75, of Malone, NY died suddenly Tuesday, August 25, 2020 at home with her family after a long illness. Born in Malone, August 2, 1945 she was the daughter of Everest and Leola Glazier. Louise graduated from Franklin Academy High School in 1964. She then moved to NYC for 12 years where she met and married Harold "Hal" Taylor of Queens, NY. They returned to Malone to raise a family.
