Margaret I. Moore, 100, of State Route 374, Merrill died Tuesday, August 21, 2018 at her home surrounded by her loving family and aided by Hospice of the North Country.

Born on October 16, 1917 in Ellenburg, NY, she was the daughter of Nelson and Nellie (Fifield) LaPoint.

She is survived by two daughters, Cynthia Dowd and her husband, William of Chateaugay Lake, Shirley Jones of Malone; a son, Lawrence Ashline and his wife, Tina of Constable; two daughters-in-law, Marcia Ashline of Grand Isle, VT, Nancy Ashline of Chateaugay; 17 grandchildren; 27 great-grandchildren;

11 great-great-grandchildren and three more on the way as well as several nieces and nephews.
