May was born in Scotland in 1936 to the late Phillip and Isabella (Isa) Moore. She emigrated with her parents to Canada in 1947 and to the United States in 1983.

May attended school in Scotland and Valleyfield, Quebec. She graduated from Valleyfield Teachers College and taught school in Valleyfield and Montreal and held various positions at Alice Hyde Medical Center in Malone NY from 1988 until 2002, including Director of Volunteers and Public Relations and Cancer Center Interpreter. She was married to Gaetan Hébert (deceased) which ended in divorce. May married Truman Richards of Malone NY in 1983, he predeceased her in 2018. They lived in Malone and spent winters in Florida. She is survived by her daughter Barbra Hébert of Laval, Quebec and her partner Steve, as well as her beloved grandchildren Philippe, Jeremy and Lily and a sister Isabelle. May was predeceased by her parents, a brother, her husband Truman and her son Barry.
