Molly Anne Flynn, 64, of Burke, passed away Monday, June 24, 2024 at the Alice Hyde Medical Center with her loving family by her side after a long and courageous battle with pancreatic cancer.

She was born on November 27, 1959 in Malone, NY, the daughter of Cleophas and Elaine (Dufore) Flynn.

Molly graduated from Chateaugay Central School in 1978 as the Valedictorian of her class and was also a member of the National Honor Society. After high school, Molly attended SUNY Canton ATC, where she graduated with an honors degree in accounting. She was employed by TJ Toyota of Potsdam for 42 plus years, retiring in 2022. She enjoyed reading, crafting, crocheting and spending time with her family.
