Nancy V. Bishop, 86, of Ellenburg died Friday, April 25, 2025, at CVPH Medical Center.

Born on February 19, 1939, at home in the Town of Ellenburg on the Bradley Pond Road, she was the daughter of Fred and Hazel (Ormsbee) Vreeland.
