



Mr. Nikolaos "Nick" Eggink

April 17, 1943 - October 2, 2024

Nikolaos "Nick" Eggink, 81, of Mountain View died October 2 following a brief illness. He is survived by his wife, Patricia, and one brother, George. Also surviving are two daughters and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by two sisters, Cathy and Mary, and a brother, Ted. No services are planned at this time.

Nick was born in Greece and emigrated to the United States with his parents and later served in the U.S. Army stationed in Germany 1961-63. He played important roles in veterans organizations in Northern New York State, including as Commander of American Legion Post 219 in Malone, Franklin County Legion Commander, Disabled American Veterans Post 182 Commander, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and a member of the Veterans Firing Squad in Malone. Twenty years ago he was honored as Legionnaire of the Year by Post 219, and in 2022 was aboard North Country Honor Flight 46 to Washington, DC.

He had worked at Alcoa in Massena and, with his wife, owned and operated the former Plaza Restaurant in Malone for several years. A master of the grill, Nick enjoyed entertaining friends.

Nick also had been active in community groups and clubs in Franklin County and volunteered most recently as a driver for the Town of Bellmont Food Pantry.
