Rachel M. Parent, 91, formerly of Churubusco died Wednesday, May 29, 2013 at Meadowbrook Nursing Home, Plattsburgh, NY.

Born in Canada on Nov. 3, 1921, she was the daughter of Aldage and Eglantine (Yelle) LaFave.

She was married to Oliver M. Parent on November 18, 1940 in Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, Churubusco. He predeceased her on Sept. 23, 2007.
