



## Mr. Robert "Bob" Queor Sr.

Robert F. Queor, Sr., 74, of Malone died Tuesday, July 12, 2022 at the Alice Hyde Medical Center.

Born on Nov. 26, 1947 in Massena, NY, he was the son of Edward and Matilda (Pofok) Queor.
