



Mr. Robert J. Roussel Jr.

February 27, 1934 - April 27, 2023

Robert J. Roussel, Jr., 89, passed away at his home on April 27, 2023, just hours after the 53rd anniversary of his marriage to Jeanne (Peets) Roussel. Robert was born to Robert Sr. and Ellen (Morris) Roussel on February 27, 1934, in Boston, Massachusetts. As a teenager, he joined the U.S. Navy and served during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged, married and settled in Phoenix, AZ. After divorce, he returned to the Boston area where he worked for 26 years as a parts finisher for the production of precision measuring and manufacturing equipment. There he met Jeanne and they married in 1970.

Robert was the father of four children, Robert III, (predeceased) of Phoenix, AZ, Charles of Tucson, AZ, James of Glendale, AZ, and Charlotte of Phoenix, AZ, and had numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren. James, his wife Stefany, their children and grandchildren surrounded Robert with love during his final days.

Robert and Jeanne retired and moved to Chateaugay in 1990, where he was a proud member of Chateaugay American Legion Post #875. He worked as a school bus driver at Chateaugay Central School. He was a long-time member of the Malone Golf Course and enjoyed many rounds with friends until failing health curtailed his activities. He also took great pleasure in bowling and had two 700 games in his later years.

At his insistence, there were no calling hours or services. His ashes are interred at the Earlville Cemetery near his home. His interment was

accompanied by an honor guard salute from members of Chateaugay American Legion Post #875. The family is grateful to Hospice of the North Country for their caring assistance during his final days, and to the Chateaugay Funeral Home for their gentle final arrangements.
