Ronald Richard Henderson, 82, of Chateaugay Lake, passed away Tuesday, February 21, 2023 at his home with his loving wife and family by his side and aided by Hospice of the North Country.

Born on January 14, 1941 in Malone, NY he was the son of Howard and Velma (Burgess) Henderson.

He was married to Janice Ann Ploof on February 24, 1962 at St. Ann's Church, St. Regis Falls by Rev. Michael Jarecki.

Ronald graduated from Franklin Academy, Malone in the class of 1959. He enlisted in the United States Army National Guard in 1958 and was honorably discharged in 1966. He was employed as a mechanic for Alcoa in Massena before retiring in 1999. He was a communicant of St. Patrick's Church, Chateaugay and was a Fourth-Degree member of the Knights of Columbus.
