Ronald J. Wilcox, 70, of Brainardsville died Friday, August 10, 2012 at Alice Hyde Medical Center, Malone, NY after being stricken at the Figure 8 Mountain Club where he was spending time with his daughters and his favorite people - his grandchildren.

Born in Belmont, NY on July 21, 1942, he was the son of Hubert and Zilda (Gardner) Wilcox.
