Doris, Tammie and Eric I hope you get a chance to see this and remember who I am. I'm the 3rd oldest child of Armand and Margaret Carey Fleury.

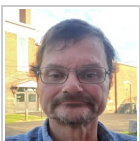
Please except my deepest condolences on the passing of Scott Cook. I will keep your family in my prayers.
