Teresa Carter, 88, of Plattsburgh, formerly of Chateaugay died Saturday, Oct. 25, 2014 at CVPH Medical Center, Plattsburgh, NY.

Born in Ellenburg Center, NY on March 30, 1926, she was the daughter of Henry and Lena (Rabideau) LaBarre.

She was married to Ray L. Carter on November 16, 1946 in Ellenburg Corners. He predeceased her on March 16, 2002.

Mrs. Carter graduated from Ellenburg Central School with the Class of 1944 and from Loretta Business School, Plattsburgh in 1945. She was employed as bookkeeper for her husband's farm, Carter's Pride Potato Farm, retiring in 1987. She was a communicant of St. Patrick's Church, Chateaugay also she attended St. Peter's Church while living in Plattsburgh and a member of the Chateaugay American Legion Auxiliary.
