Terry H. Baker, 73, of Chateaugay Lake, died Friday, October 21, 2022, at CVPH Medical Center.

Born on May 7, 1949, in Malone, NY, he was the son of Lyndon “Buzz” and Phyllis (Cooper) Baker.

He was married to Ann Vanderwalker on July 11, 1981, at Centenary Methodist Church, Malone.

Terry graduated from Franklin Academy with the Class of 1967. He served in the Army National Guard and was honorably discharged. He drove tractor trailer and then became employed for the Franklin County Highway Dept. and Solid Waste Facility from which he retired.
