Theresa Bova Patnode, formerly of Burke and Plattsburgh, passed away on Tuesday morning, October 13, 2020 at the Alice Center in Malone where she had been a resident since March 2019.

Born in Malone on March 20, 1928, she was the daughter of Fred and Mae (Denesha) Bova of Burke. They predeceased her. She was also predeceased by five brothers, Fred Jr., Gerald, Thomas, James and Willard as well as a sister, Betty Marx.

Theresa is survived by three sons, Lawrence J. Patnode of Massena, Richard Patnode of Malone and Allan Patnode and his spouse, Rick Storms of Albany. 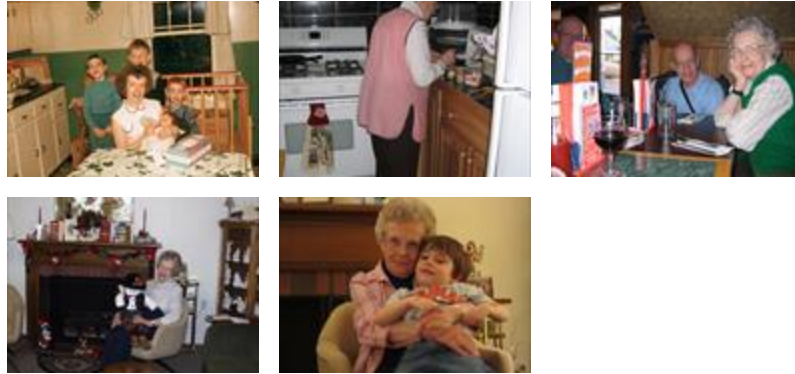

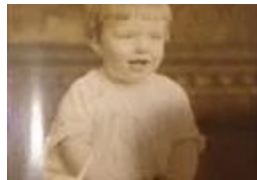
