William (Bill) P. Boyea, 64, of Chateaugay passed away Tuesday, August 15, 2017 surrounded by his loving family. Born August 5, 1953 in Malone, New York to Henry and Lavina Patenaude Boyea.

that are cherished by those nieces and nephews. As a brother, Bill was beyond compare and will be greatly missed by his siblings.

He is survived by his mother, Lavina Patenaude Boyea of Chateaugay.
