William W. Crawford, 66, of West Main St., Chateaugay died Monday, Nov. 3, 2014 at Alice Hyde Medical Center, Malone, NY.

Born in Huntingdon, Quebec, Canada on Dec. 10, 1947, he was the son of Robert and Norma (Wilson) Crawford. They predeceased him.

He was married to Margaret Bova on June 12, 1971 in St. Patrick's Church, Chateaugay.

Bill became employed for Conrail in Huntingdon, Quebec in 1969 and retired in 1989. He was also employed at the Franklin County Sheriff's Dept., Malone for two years and was employed as a corrections officer at Franklin County Correctional Facility, Malone, retiring in 2010 after 21 years of service.
