



## Mr. William J. Rogers Jr

September 12, 1938 - April 17, 2022

William J. Rogers Jr., 83 of Ellenburg Depot, passed away April 17, 2022 at CVPH Medical Center, Plattsburgh with his companion, Marilyn Noyes by his side.

Born on September 12, 1938 in Boston, MA, he was the son of William J. Sr. and Pauline (O'Connor) Rogers.

He graduated from St. Mary's of the Assumption in Brookline, MA and from Peterson of Steam Engineering in Massachusetts. He worked as a District Engineering Inspector for the Department of Public Safety for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. He enlisted in the United States Navy in 1957 and was honorably discharged in 1963, serving on the USS Randolph Aircraft. He was a member of the VFW Post 8793 in Ellenburg and the Disabled American Veterans Chapter 179 in Plattsburgh. He was an avid hunter and fisherman and loved being outdoors.
